HOW DO URBAN BIRDS USE GREEN SPACES?

Help us find out. It's easy, fun, and quick!

WHAT TO DO:

First pick a time and outdoor place, then watch birds for 10 minutes. Complete both sides of this form. Send the information to the Cornell Lab of Ornithology--even if you saw no birds.

HOW TO DO IT:

- **1. Pick a date, time, and place** (balcony, yard, park, etc.) for your bird watch **BEFORE** you go out. Don't change your place or time just because you see an exciting bird elsewhere. That would skew your results. OPTIONAL: You can watch birds on one or two additional days in the same week.
- 2. Set the bounds of your bird-watching area. Go to your chosen place and imagine a limited area around you that is about 50 feet x 50 feet (about the size of half a basketball court or 20 x 20 adult paces). Don't worry if your area is smaller than half a basketball court or if your view is limited to a smaller area. Just note that in question 2 below.
- **3.** At the time you chose, start your 10-minute bird watch, even if no birds are present when you begin. On the other side of this form, record which birds you see in your bird-watching area.
